Obtaining reliable counts for vehicles in these convoys is challenging due to factors including multiple convoys; road conditions and closures delaying or diverting portions of different convoys; convoys splitting up; staggered departure times; and vehicles joining and leaving the convoys at different points as it is moving.*

## POLICE INFORMATION & OBSERVATIONS

*Items in this section are presented in order of seriousness of the potential threat:*

1. The Sûreté du Québec has advised that members of the East Convoy are taking security seriously, blocking all of the entrances to the parking lot at one rest stop to prevent anyone not in the convoy from approaching. **(RELIABLE)**
2. Police observation has identified what may be a large air compressor being transported on a flat-bed trailer in the convoy. The item is similar in appearance to the below image. It occupies the entire flat bed trailer. **(RELIABLE)**

## OPEN SOURCE INFORMATION (Media and Social Media)

*Information from open sources, including the media and social media, is critical for developing all-source intelligence that provides context, and which identifies indicators of ideologies, beliefs, and attitudes that motivate subjects of interest and influence their behaviours. This component of all-source intelligence is vital for informing law enforcement in developing strategies and tactics to prevent, mitigate or respond to potential threats.*

*Items in this section are presented in order of seriousness of the potential threat:*

3. Open source research has identified a YouTube channel that appears to be live-streaming police communications (Belleville PS; Ottawa PS; and the OPP) regarding the location and movement of the various convoys. Further open source research located a social media message indicating that the author had been listening specifically to the OPP radio traffic. **(UNKNOWN)**
4. Open source research has identified social media messaging suggesting that some individuals attending the Ottawa protest may attend one or more hospitals in Ottawa. One social media user responded with “!!THE FUCKERS ARE PLANNING TO BLOCK HOSPITALS!!” It is unknown if any individual attending the protest actually has the intent to do so. **(UNKNOWN)**
5. In a video posted on the CANADA UNITY Facebook page, [REDACTED] who is driving in the convoy, indicates that OPERATION BEARHUG was intended to “bring the law to Ottawa” and that they will not leave the city until the law has been restored and they get their lawful freedom back. While [REDACTED] states that they have made plans so that members of the public and public transportation in Ottawa will not be disrupted, he also hints that there are plans that they cannot make public for strategic and security reasons. [REDACTED] further states that he anticipates that they will win in Ottawa, after which they will proceed to the United States to support the truck drivers there. He further references a Memorandum of Understanding that has been prepared, that, once signed, will result in Prime Minister TRUDEAU, Erin O'TOOLE and the “NDP leader” stepping down. **(UNKNOWN)**
6. Open source research identified a 15-page Memorandum of Understanding to be submitted by CANADA UNITY for signature to the Governor General and the Speaker of the Senate, George FUREY. Signatories for CANADA UNITY are listed as [REDACTED] **(RELIABLE)**

**Analyst Comment:** We believe that this is the document to which [REDACTED] refers in the video described in paragraph 5.

- Open source research has captured a still image of a flatbed tractor-trailer carrying a pick-up truck and a smaller piece of equipment, possibly a construction light tower, posted on a Facebook page called CONVOY TO OTTAWA 2022 RESTART on 2022-01-27. Open source research also captured an image of another flat-bed truck carrying another pick-up truck and portable toilets, as well as what may be an excavator being transported by a truck in the convoy. This is the third piece of heavy equipment observed in the convoy. **(RELIABLE)**



- Media reporting has cited a convoy organizer stating that farmers were bringing bulldozers to remove snow and make room for the transport trucks to park. The location was not stated, but it is inferred that she was referring to Ottawa. **(UNKNOWN)**
- Open source research has identified an image of a large boat on a flat-bed trailer with “#JTs SHIP IS SUNK” spray painted on the side, as well as the Nazi insignia “SS” and the word “CASTREAU”. We infer that these comments are directed toward the Prime Minister. A small loader is also on the trailer. **(RELIABLE)**

**Analyst Comment:** *It is possible that this image may have been taken as the Freedom Convoy was passing through Milton. It is unknown whether the vessel is intended for use in any capacity in Ottawa or whether it is simply to make a statement.*

10. Open source research has also identified a image of what appears to be a large all-terrain vehicle being hauled in the convoy.



***Analyst Comment:** The vehicle in question may be a SHERP amphibian utility task vehicle.*

11. Open source research has identified social media messaging encouraging convoy participants to remain peaceful and not carry anything that might be construed as a weapon. The author also suggests that paid actors may attend the protest and cause problems for which convoy participants will be blamed, just as members of the PROUD BOYS were after the January 2021 insurrection at the US Capitol Building. The author further notes that police will not stop a riot if one begins, and participants should restrain individuals who are misbehaving as long as neither party gets hurt. **(UNRELIABLE)**
12. Open source research identified a CBC interview of two individuals in the convoy: they advised that they wanted to take their country back, and one was wearing a yellow star patch on his jacket reminiscent of the one that Jews were forced to wear under Germany's Nazi regime. Protestors against COVID-19-related public health measures in Europe and the United States have been reported and observed wearing similar patches. **(RELIABLE)**

Some responses to a Tweet on the OPP's Twitter page regarding the closure of part of Highway #17 due to poor weather on 2022-01-27 express cynicism, anger, and claim that the weather was fine and that this was merely an excuse to delay or halt the convoy. Similar narratives were identified on other social media sites. **(UNRELIABLE)**
14. Regarding the same road closure noted in paragraph 13, another social media user posted a video with a caption indicating that the government had closed the road and that the convoy might be stopped. One individual suggested blocking all of the routes, including rail lines, as that would result in the roads being re-opened. **(UNRELIABLE)**
15. In addition to using the ZELLO mobile application to communicate, open source research has yielded information to suggest that some convoy participants may also be using SIGNAL. **(UNKNOWN)**
16. Open source research has identified a social media comment indicating that the convoy drivers need a lot of food and that supporters were moving it to the road for them. **(BELIEVED RELIABLE)**
17. Media reporting indicates that protest organizers have arranged for scheduled events every day until they receive a response from the government to their demands. The reporting indicates that a stage will be set up in a park on 2022-01-31 and politicians, truck drivers, and Indigenous elders will be speaking. The reporting also indicates that the convoy is scheduled to remain in Ottawa for a week, but will stay longer if COVID-19 vaccine mandates are not lifted. **(UNKNOWN)**
18. The GoFundMe account supporting the Freedom Convoy has raised \$7.1 million (2022-01-28 1155 hours). **(RELIABLE)**
19. The "ADOPT A TRUCKER" fundraiser has raised \$46,447 (2022-01-28 1156 hours). **(RELIABLE)**

## ASSESSMENT

The available information indicates that the protestors plan to remain in Ottawa at least until 2022-02-04. We continue to identify indicators to support at least some protestors remaining beyond the weekend of 2022-01-29/30. These indicators include collecting donations of cash, food, and water from supporters along the route.

**The reason for the convoys transporting the noted pieces of heavy equipment is unknown and represents an intelligence gap.**

We continue to assess that fringe elements amongst the convoy participants and supporters likely represent the greatest potential threat to public order and safety posed by the Freedom Convoy/Operation BearHug 2.0

protest. The apparent hesitance to discuss plans for Ottawa and the behaviour of the participants of the East Convoy indicate a degree of security awareness and security culture amongst some groups or individuals who plan to attend the protest in Ottawa, as does the potential use of SIGNAL.

██████████ appears to be focused primarily on Operation BearHug 2.0 (compelling the Canadian government, and subsequently the American government, to rescind all COVID-19-related mandates). It is possible that they may attempt to attend the Prime Minister's residence in Ottawa or Harrington Lake; Rideau Hall; or the residences of the Speaker of the Senate in order to obtain their signatures on the noted Memorandum of Understanding.

While ██████████ claims that the convoy participants and supporters are prioritizing safety and do not intend to inconvenience the public, some social media users appear to be encouraging illegal acts, including blocking hospitals. The angry reaction to this suggestion on social media suggests that there is a potential for conflict amongst protest attendees.

Misinformation and disinformation continues to feed distrust of the government and the police, which may result in defiance towards law enforcement in Ottawa or a disregard for the law and public order. It is likely that some protest participants will believe the "false flag" narrative of paid actors at the protest, and this may provoke conflict amongst protest attendees, particularly if any attempts are made by protestors to restrain or apprehend other protestors. Any such incident has the potential to escalate and could require a police response.

Erroneous information online regarding the participation of American truck drivers and broad support from Indigenous peoples, as well as the number of supporters attending along the convoy route, has likely raised the expectations of protest attendees.

**Project HENDON has not identified any concrete, specific, or credible threat with regard to the Freedom Convoy protest or OPERATION BEARHUG. However, the possibility that a lone actor or group of individuals could enact a physical threat with little or no warning cannot be excluded.**

### TACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Unconfirmed information of unknown reliability suggests that **some convoy participants or supporters may bring weapons** with them to Ottawa;
- Police communications on convoy movements appear to be monitored and re-broadcast on YouTube;
- Potential live-streaming of protest by attendees;
- Some attendees may be using the SIGNAL app (encrypted) for communication;
- Potential use of drones for counter-surveillance and tactical planning;
- Spontaneous convoys may organize with no warning.

- Nature and location of evening event in Kingston (2022-01-27);
- Plans for any further action should demands not be met;
- Plans for departing Ottawa.
