We've just received the latest number of frozen accounts from the banks. The total is now up to 76 accounts frozen (mix of corporate and retail accounts) for a total of \$3,240,940.21.

We expect the next update will be even higher as the CBA will be receiving data from a larger set of entities (medium and smaller sized banks).

We'll continue to keep you apprised of any updates.
